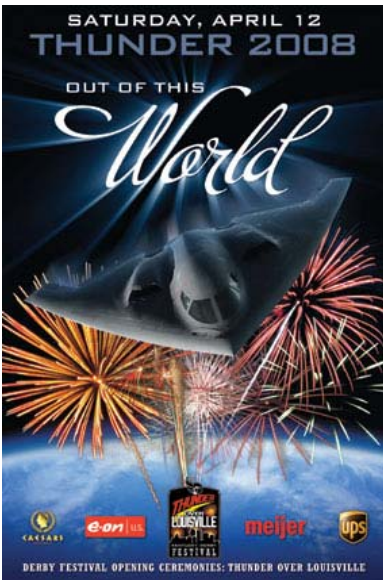

## THUNDER 2008: OUT OF THIS WORLD

The nation's largest annual fireworks event, Thunder Over Louisville has entertained millions and garnered Louisville international attention. With the support of the community, sponsors, and city officials, the show has become the region's largest annual event, attracting a regional and even national audience. The air show was slowly added as a way to stagger the crowd entering the event and provide entertainment before the 9:30 p.m. fireworks. The air show is now an event of its own and ranks in the top five air shows in the nation!

### HELPFUL HINTS FOR THUNDER

- Bring your patience. This is not an event for the crowd-shy. Remember the event is for fun and try to have some!
- Wear comfortable shoes and be prepared to walk.

- Bring sunglasses & sunscreen - April is notorious for burns.
- Keep your coolers, cans, bottles, weapons and pets at home. You may bring food in a paper bag or basket.
- Make sure your car has plenty of gas for the traffic delays.
- Be aware of the services around and identify a location to regroup should you lose anyone in your party.
- Dress in layers. The temperature can vary a great deal throughout the day.
- Know what your children are wearing and carry a photo of them with you. Make sure they know their phone number and address.
