CancerMD develops and manages cancer treatment centers primarily in locations that previously did not have direct access to comprehensive cancer care services. Development sites range from east to west, including Hawaii and Guam over the past 22 years. These services include radiation and medical oncology, radiation physics and dosimetry and operations management. Recent advancements in computer technology and robotics have drastically improved the delivery of precision based “radiosurgery”.

Radiosurgery is a painless, noninvasive method of treating localized cancerous and noncancerous tumors in the brain, lung, pancreas, liver and prostate. CyberKnifeMD is developing facilities in urban areas, including Greater Louisville, with a population basis of approximately one million people which do not have local access to this technology.
