**Winter Weather Driving Tips**

- Decrease your speed and leave yourself plenty of room to stop. You should allow at least three times more space than usual between you and the car in front of you.
- Brake gently to avoid skidding. If your wheels do start to lock up, ease off the brake.
- Use low gears to keep traction, especially on hills.
- Don't use cruise control or overdrive on ice roads.
- Be especially careful on bridges or overpasses, which freeze first.

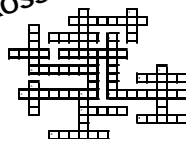
