SPRING FORWARD! DAYLIGHT SAVINGS TIME IS APPROACHING

You know that springtime is right around the corner when you're reminded to set your clocks ahead one hour! Daylight Savings Time (DST) begins on Sunday, March 11th this year, and many look forward to this annual tradition because of the extra hour of sunlight it adds to the days. DST was first established in 1918 by the US Congress, but it was a widely unpopular con-

cept at that time and was repealed just one year later. DST is not observed all over the world; in fact, there are areas in the US that don't observe it or are attempting to repeal it in their area (Arizona and Hawaii do not observe DST).

**TOWER TIPS:
TORNADO / HEAVY WINDS PROCEDURES**

Most everyone has heard the month of March described as "coming in like a lion and going out like a lamb," illustrating the bouts of varied and severe weather that plague the early spring month. One weather phenomenon that all residents of Kentuckiana are aware of and begin preparing for at this time of year are tornados. Kentucky and Southern Indiana's peak months for tornado season are April through June. National City Tower Management advises all tenants to know and practice the safety procedures in place to ensure that everyone in the Tower is safe in the event of a strong wind storm.

Every tenant is responsible for providing Floor Wardens, representatives who have been educated and trained by building management as to what to do in the event of an emergency. Your Floor Warden is the "go-to" person for finding out what should be done to prepare yourself for inclement weather while at work.

What are the best ways to prepare as tornado season approaches?

- 1) Find out who your Floor Wardens are and talk with them about your plan!
- 2) In the event of a storm, move away from the windows toward the center of the building.

3) Do not congregate in the main lobby. Stay on your floor, away from windows.

4) Participate in National City Tower's Tornado Drill on Wednesday, April 4th! More information will be released as the date gets closer.
