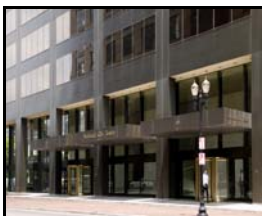

I also donate, rather than throw away, unneeded household items and clothing. The largest waste of electricity in a business environment is lighting, and I no longer use my desk lighting as the overhead fixtures are sufficient for my needs...when people leave work early, I turn off any office lights that are unneeded. If everyone in our building did this, imagine how much coal we'd save over a one-month period!"
